Master's Degree programme in Global Health and Crisis Management

90 credits

Study contents

Master's Degree Programme in Global Health and Crisis Management focuses on health care development and management from the perspectives of global health and humanity, health and infection prevention, and crisis management. The studies of this 1.5 - 2.5-years programme are offered in English, and they can be completed alongside a full-time job. The candidates are awarded the qualification of Master of Health Care.

The students encounters global health topics and challenges in development and management when creating working theories and practices for the good of health care service users. and people in man-made or natural crisis.

Cooperation with international health care organisations plays an important role in the studies. During the studies, students will also have a possibility to participate in international projects abroad and take studies from Laurea's partner institutes.

Study objectives





The graduates students will have the ability to perform evidence-based, ethical, and cross-cultural practice, as well as self-management. They will have competencies in front line, project and quality management; and in complementary expertise according to their choices in global, international and transnational contexts. They are able to implement and develop global health policies as well as work within global health research and development projects and organizations.

Structure of the studies

- ◆ Compulsory studies 30 ECTS credits
- ◆ Elective studies 30 ECTS credits
- ◆ Master thesis 30 ECTS credits

Master thesis 30 ECTS credits will be completed within national or international/transnational development or research project integrating theoretical studies with health care development and/or management.

The exam consists of a text-related written exam (including a self-reflection) and a group discussion.</p>	<p>Non-EU/EEA area students who have been selected through the Finnish joint application for admission to degree programmes taught in English will be charged tuition fees of 10 000€ per academic year for Master's degree programmes. Fee paying students have completed at least 60 credits of studies that count to-wards their degree programme can apply for a grant that is equivalent of at most 10% of the tuition fee.</p>
